John 4:1 – 29

4:3 Jesus left Judea and went away again into Galilee. ⁴ And he had to pass through Samaria.

John 4:1 – 29

5 So he came to a city of Samaria called Sychar, near the parcel of ground that Jacob gave to his son Joseph

⁶ and Jacob's well was there. So Jesus, being wearied from his journey, was sitting thus by the well. It was about the sixth hour.

⁷ There came a woman of Samaria to draw water.

Jesus said to her, ‘Give me a drink.’ ⁸ For his disciples had gone away into the city to buy food.

John 4:1 – 29

9 Therefore the Samaritan woman said to him, ‘How is it that you, being a Jew, ask me for a drink since I am a Samaritan woman?’
(For Jews have no dealings with Samaritans.)

¹⁰ Jesus answered and said to her, ‘If you knew the gift of God, and who it is who says to you, ‘Give me a drink,’ you would have asked him, and he would have given you living water.’

¹¹ She said to him, ‘Sir, you have nothing to draw with and the well is deep; where then do you get that living water?’

John 4:1 – 29

¹² ‘You are not greater than our father Jacob, are you, who gave us the well, and drank of it himself and his sons and his cattle?’

John 4:1 – 29

¹³ Jesus answered and said to her, ‘Everyone who drinks of this water will thirst again; ¹⁴ but whoever drinks of the water that I will give him shall never thirst;

but the water that I will
give him will become in
him a well of water
springing up to eternal
life.'

¹⁵ The woman said to him,
‘Sir, give me this water, so I
will not be thirsty nor
come all the way here to
draw.’

¹⁶ He said to her, ‘Go, call your husband and come here.’ ¹⁷ The woman answered and said, ‘I have no husband.’

Jesus said to her, ‘You have correctly said, ‘I have no husband; ¹⁸ for you have had five husbands,

and the one whom you
now have is not your
husband; this you have
said truly.'

¹⁹ The woman said to him,
‘Sir, I perceive that you are
a prophet.’

John 4:1 – 29

²⁰ Our fathers worshiped in this mountain, and you people say that in Jerusalem is the place where men ought to worship.'

John 4:1 – 29

²¹ Jesus said to her,
‘Woman, believe me, an
hour is coming when
neither in this mountain
nor in Jerusalem will you
worship the Father.

John 4:1 – 29

²² You worship what you do not know; we worship what we know, for salvation is from the Jews.'

²³ But an hour is coming,
and now is, when the true
worshipers will worship
the Father in spirit and
truth;

for such people the Father seeks to be his worshipers.

²⁴ God is spirit, and those who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.'

John 4:1 – 29

²⁵ The woman said to him, ‘I know that Messiah is coming (he who is called Christ); when that One comes, he will declare all things to us.’

John 4:1 – 29

²⁶ Jesus said to her, 'I who speak to you am he.'

John 4:1 – 29

²⁸ So the woman left her waterpot, and went into the city and said to the men,

²⁹ ‘Come, see a man who told me all the things that I have done; this is not the Christ, is it?’
